New Saratoga Train Station

Restoration of an historic rail station

This project involved the demolition and restoration of an historic train station in the upstate New York resort town of Saratoga Springs, NY. The design features of the new **CDTA Saratoga Train Station** reflect the style of the surrounding Saratoga community.

Improvements at the rail site included a new entrance road, new utility connections, enhancement of intermodal access and new infrastructure.

Structural improvements included all new utilities, new station façade and new roof. The new structure has a larger passenger waiting area, larger windowed areas, and retail space.

U.W. Marx provided construction management services to the **Capital District Transportation Authority**, working with the owner and project designer **Argus Architecture and Preservation** to deliver substantial savings through value engineering.
