Franklin D. Roosevelt Presidential Library Renovation & Restoration

Renovation & restoration at national historic site

This prestigious project was awarded to U.W. Marx by the National Archives and Records Administration. NARA conducted a nation-wide search for a construction company with proven experience in historic restoration and renovation.

The award-winning project included construction of the new **Henry A. Wallace Visitor, Education & Conference Center**, and extensive renovations and restoration at the **Franklin D. Roosevelt Presidential Library and Museum**.

Renovation work at the original library building included substantial repair and restoration of the library's roof system, as well as the creation of a new 3,000 s/f special exhibit gallery. The project also included replacement of windows in a number of buildings at the National Historic Site.

Working together with the owner's representatives and project architects R.M. Kliment and Frances Halsband Architects of New York City, the U.W. Marx team has improved visitor access to the library, constructed new storage space, expanded the area available for permanent exhibitions, and built new administrative offices.
