New Wallace Visitor Center

New construction of the Henry A. Wallace Visitor, Education and Conference Center

This award-winning project included new construction of the **Henry A. Wallace Visitor, Education & Conference Center**, and extensive renovations and restoration at the **FDR Presidential Library and Museum**.

The new 25,000 s/f Wallace Center is the first major new construction project in 60 years at the Roosevelt Library and National Historic Site, and serves as entry point for the site's more than 125,000 annual visitors.

The new building offers multipurpose rooms designed for conferences, school groups, and special programs, as well as a café and new museum store.

The Center also includes state-of-the-art audio-visual facilities and a 140-seat auditorium for presentation of a high definition film depicting the lives of Franklin and Eleanor Roosevelt, and visitor orientation exhibits.
