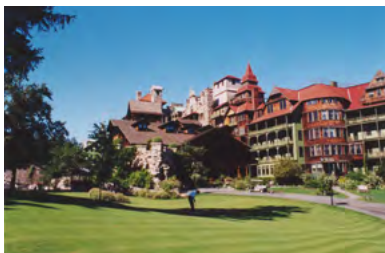
## Mohonk Mountain House Renovations

### *Renovations to dining and catering facilities*

U.W. Marx Construction Company constructed significant renovations and improvements to the commercial kitchens and catering facilities of the historic **Mohonk Mountain House**, located on Lake Mohonk outside the village of New Paltz, NY.

The Mohonk Mountain House was constructed between 1879 and 1910 by Alfred and Albert Smiley, and was designated a National Historic Landmark in 1986.

The 266-room hotel was once the subject of an original Currier and Ives picture print, and was featured in the 1995 feature film "The Road to Wellville" starring Sir Anthony Hopkins.
