## Linda A. Norris Auditorium

*Renovations to historic bank building to create new performance venue*

U.W. Marx renovated and restored a historically significant bank building in Albany, NY into a live performance theater and radio studio for **WAMC Northeast Public Radio**.

The award-winning project included construction of the new 200-seat **Linda A. Norris Auditorium** and installation of a state-of-the-art radio and studio sound booth.

A particularly noteworthy feature of the project is the original bank's vault door, which was retained and incorporated into the design of the restored facility as the door to the green room.

The CM At-Risk project was recognized by the NY-NJ Metro Chapter of the **Construction Management Association of America** as **2002 Project of the Year**.
