

## van den Berg Learning Center *Renovation & Rehabilitation*

### SUNY New Paltz

*New Paltz, NY*

Phases I & II of a major facility upgrade for the **State University Construction Fund** on the **SUNY New Paltz campus**. The multi-phased project successfully rehabilitated the entire historic van den Berg building to accommodate the School of Business and the Nursing Program.

Phase I's scope of work in the 67,700 SF building included interior demolition, upgrades to the mechanical, electrical, plumbing and fire alarm systems, new interior partitions and finishes, and a new elevator.

Phase II's renovation doubled the amount of classroom and lab space for the School of Business and included construction of several state-of-the-art classrooms wired with the latest educational technology, including 17 "smart" classrooms. These classrooms are now outfitted with video-data projectors, sound systems, DVD/VCR playback, desktop computer/video/audio inputs and document camera touch-screen or push-button system controllers. Two of these classrooms have been equipped with distance learning technology.
