The 37 new townhouse-style dormitories encompass more than 120,000 sf of new construction, and can accommodate nearly 600 students.

The two residence halls feature single- and double-occupancy bedroom apartments, and living quarters with shared bath facilities.

Each suite has a common living area with Internet connections, fire alarm systems, cable television access, telephone service, kitchen, laundry facilities and parking.
